Reading is important and so much fun!

Learning how to read is not always easy, especially in a new language. For this reason Caritas launched a project called “Lesementoren – Leggi insieme a me” (Reading Mentors):

What is a reading mentor?

Reading mentors are volunteers who read with a child for one hour a week. It doesn't matter whether it is a book or a magazine – the reading material is chosen according to the skills and the interests of the child. Reading mentors do not work in school, they meet the child outside school hours in the library. They do NOT help with homework.

Reading mentors are like nice neighbors who help your child in the process of learning how to read in Italian or German.
